Beta Phi Mu was founded at the University of Illinois in August 1948 by a group of leading librarians and library educators. It has become an international honor society that recognizes graduates of library and information science programs in the United States and Canada and of approved international institutions. Since its inception, Beta Phi Mu has promoted scholarship through the setting of high standards for admission to its ranks, through distinguished publications, through lectures sponsored by its chapters, and through its program of scholarships, grants, and awards. Chi Chapter began at Indiana University in 1971, shortly after the Graduate Library School was established.
